The parliamentary Committee on Welfare of SCs and STs has asked report on the following points:-


ROSTERS

20. (a) What are the posts/groups of posts for which rosters regarding reserved vacancies are maintained by the BSNL at its head office?
 (b) What are the posts/groups of posts for which rosters are maintained by BSNL at its regional/zonal/circle offices?
 (c) Are the rosters maintained at head office as also all regional offices inspected by the Liaison Officers regularly?
 (d) Do the representatives of the Ministry of Communications (Department of Telecommunications) also visit the head office and regional/zonal/circle office of BSNL to check the rosters? If so, what type of discrepancies have come to their notice during the years 2013, 2014, 2015 and 2016 (till date) and corrective measures suggested to rectify them?

24. (a) What is the machinery for the redressal of grievances of SC/ST employees in the BSNL?
 (b) Whether any complaint register is being maintained showing the records of the complaints/grievances of SC/ST employees together with their disposal?
 (c) How many complaints were received from SC/ST employees during the years 2013, 2014, 2015 and 2016 (till date)?
 (d) What was the nature of these complaints and the number of complaints disposed of and the time taken for disposal of each complaint?
 (e) Please state the number of pending complaints as on date and also the period from which they are pending.
 (f) Have you come across any case of harassment or discrimination against SC/ST employees on grounds of their social origin? If so, give details thereof and action taken on each case?

Since the Parliamentary Committee has desired reply to above points urgently, therefore it is requested to furnish reply to all above points by today itself to avoid any adverse remarks from the Parliamentary Committee.
